Freshman Early Action Applicants (application due November 15):

Auditions/interviews need to be completed no later than December 1, 2010. Any auditions/interviews that take place after this time will require that the application be moved to the Regular Decision pool.

Freshman Regular Decision Applicants:

Auditions/interviews will need to be completed no later than March 1, 2011. Students who audition/interview after this time risk late consideration on a space-available basis.

Transfer Applicants:

Auditions/interviews need to be completed no later than six weeks after the admission deadline for the semester application. For spring 2011, auditions/interviews must be completed by December 1, 2010, and for fall 2011, auditions/interviews must be completed by April 1, 2011. *Students enrolling in the College of Performing Arts at Chapman University during the spring semester should expect to enroll in general education courses during their first term, and begin courses in their major during the following fall semester.*
