Please note: Xerox and other electrostatic copies are not acceptable. All letters must be specifically addressed to Chapman University and must be dated within three months of the date of the student's application to the University. A bank official's signature and bank seal are required on the certification if the student is partially or totally supported by personal savings. United States consuls scrutinize the statements of financial resources given by non-immigrant visa applicants. It is important that you answer each of the questions and obtain the appropriate signatures. Otherwise, this form will be considered incomplete and your application will continue to be pending documents. A completed Financial Certification will help United States consuls make their decisions and expedite the visa issuance.
