



Orange Campus Transfer Coursework Coding

Direct equivalencies are used for transfer coursework that are equivalent to Chapman University courses and carry the same approvals for GE and major as the Chapman course.

Transfer codes help advisors, students, and Registrar Office staff determine how transfer coursework that do not have direct equivalencies meet Chapman requirements and how they fit into the official program evaluation.

Transferability by subject does not mean automatic approval in that subject area for GE.

Prior approval on all transfer work taken after admission to Chapman University that is not listed with a direct equivalency for GE and major, is recommended. Courses that are not listed on Web Advisor have not been formally reviewed for transferability.

Courses listed on Web Advisor are subject to annual review. Approvals should be confirmed prior to the semester or term the students are considering to enroll for transfer work.
