

## What is Martindale?

Martindale is an online compilation of information on individual lawyers, law firms, and organizations.

## Why use Martindale?

You would use Martindale to do research on prospective employers and contacts, to locate Chapman University Fowler School of Law alumni, identify targets for informational interviews, and pull a variety of information for submitting applications and networking.

Users can search over one million lawyers, law firms, and companies in more than 160 countries by using a variety of criteria, including name, geographic location, practice area, firm size, language, and more.

## How to use Martindale:

- **Access to Martindale is free on Martindale.com.**
- **If you want to search for "People" (Lawyers):**
  - Type in the name of the person you are searching for in the search bar at the top of the page and click "Search."
  - You can narrow the results of your search on the left side of the page.
  - Click "Advanced search" under the search bar for more search options, such as "Law School" attended, "Job Title," "City," "Practice Areas," and more.
- **If you want to search for "Law Firms & Organizations."**
  - Click the tab, "Law Firms & Organizations" above the search bar.
  - Type in the name of the firm or organization and click search.
  - Narrow your results with the options on the left side of the page.
  - Click "Advanced search" under the search bar for more search options.
- **If you want to research law firms for cover letters and interviews:**
  - You may click on the name of any firm in your search to view the firm profile.
