Soren Soeborg is the Head of Development Cultural Centres in Denmark and involved in a European project called RECcORD—an interesting model on how Creative and Cultural Industries (CCI) works as a form of cultural diplomacy, collaborative networking, and international understanding.

Soeborg will present and discuss possible CCI collaborations and network building.

He will lead discussions on how Chapman and Wilkinson College might replicate the project here, looking at a US national model. The discussion will urge participants to think beyond what they might normally see as ‘culture’ and ‘creative,’ becoming relevant to, and supportive of, all of Wilkinson’s disciplines.
