




#### **Diversity of Fall '15 Undergrads**




# Diversity of Entire Fall '15 Full-time Student Body





# Time Elapsed From Graduation to Acceptance of Full-time Employment (2013-14 Undergraduate Degree Recipients)








#### **Educational Expenditures**




# **Instruction and Academic Support Expenses** as Percent of Total Educational Expenses
