






Diversity of Fall '17 Undergrads




Diversity of Entire Fall '17 Full-time **Student Body**





Time Elapsed From Graduation to Acceptance of Full-time Employment (2015-16 Undergraduate Degree Recipients)








Educational Expenditures




Instruction and Academic Support Expenses as Percent of Total Educational Expenses
