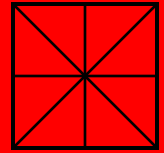

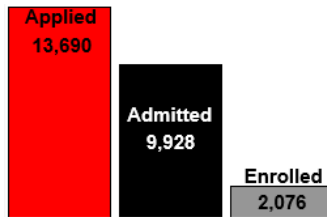

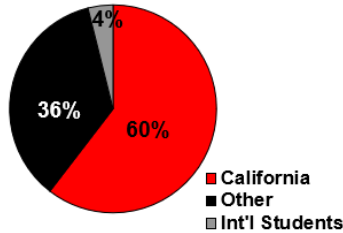

### Fall 2022 First Year Class Characteristics

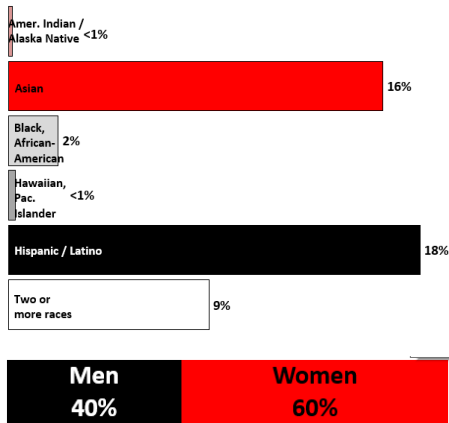

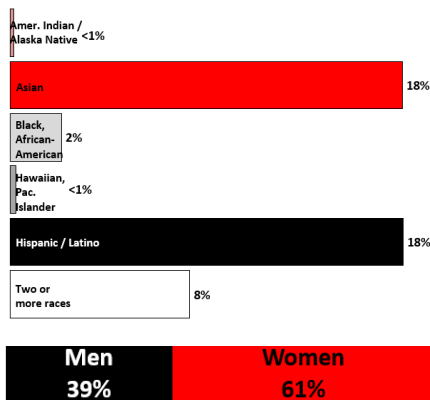
### Geographic Origin



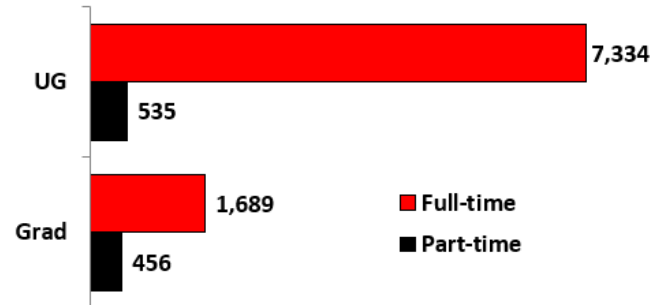
### Diversity of Fall '22 Full-time Undergrads

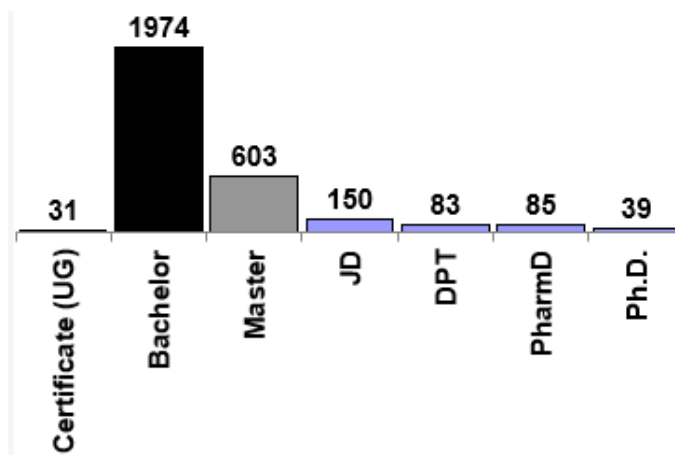

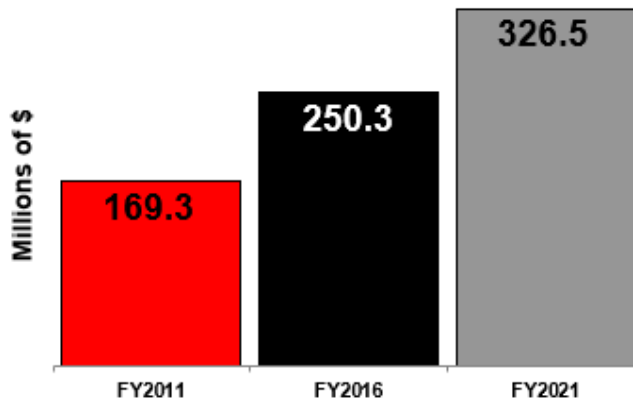

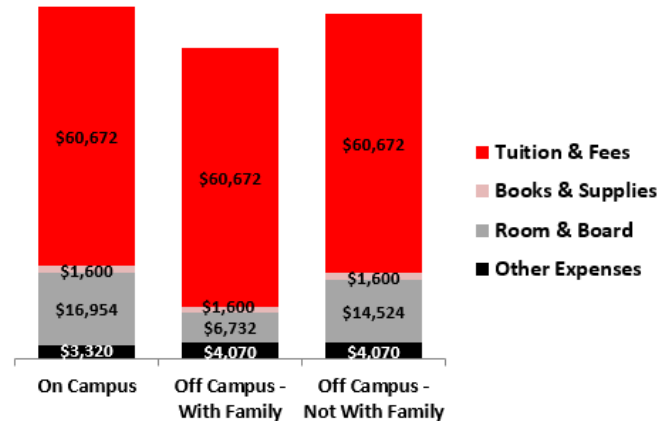

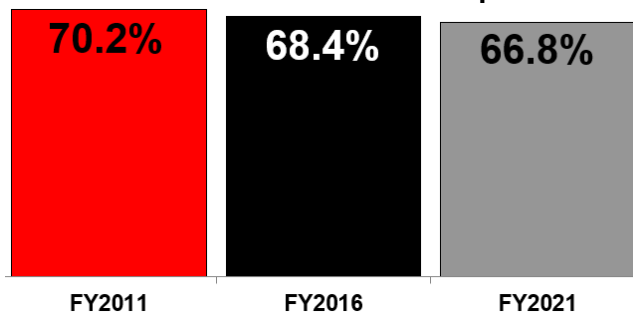
## Educational Expenditures



## Estimated Costs of Attendance (2022-23 Undergraduates)



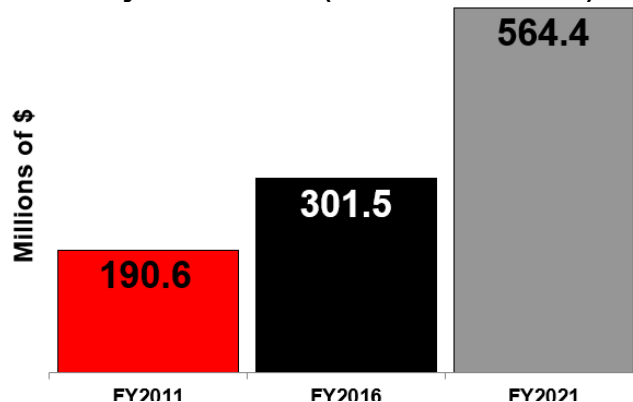
## Instruction and Academic Support Expenses as Percent of Total Educational Expenses
