Alumni Survey: Graduating Class of 2018–2019

The Alumni Survey is a homegrown survey designed to assess alumni's current educational plans, satisfaction with Chapman University, and employment history. The Alumni Survey is administrated annually to undergraduate (UG) and graduate (GR) degree recipients one year out of college. A total of 254 surveys were completed, yielding a response rate of 12% for the graduating class of 2018–2019.
