

New Joint Degree

Joint degree programs are shared programs between or among more than one academic unit.

New Joint Degree program proposals are submitted using the PDF form, following the guidelines for new program proposals described above, and should include any additional information required for the interdisciplinary degree (Appendix C, Curriculum).

Any joint degree program with another institution requires:

- A consultation with the Office of the Executive Vice President/Chief Operating Officer and the Office of Legal Affairs to identify and resolve any potential legal issues.
- A substantive change filing with WASC.
