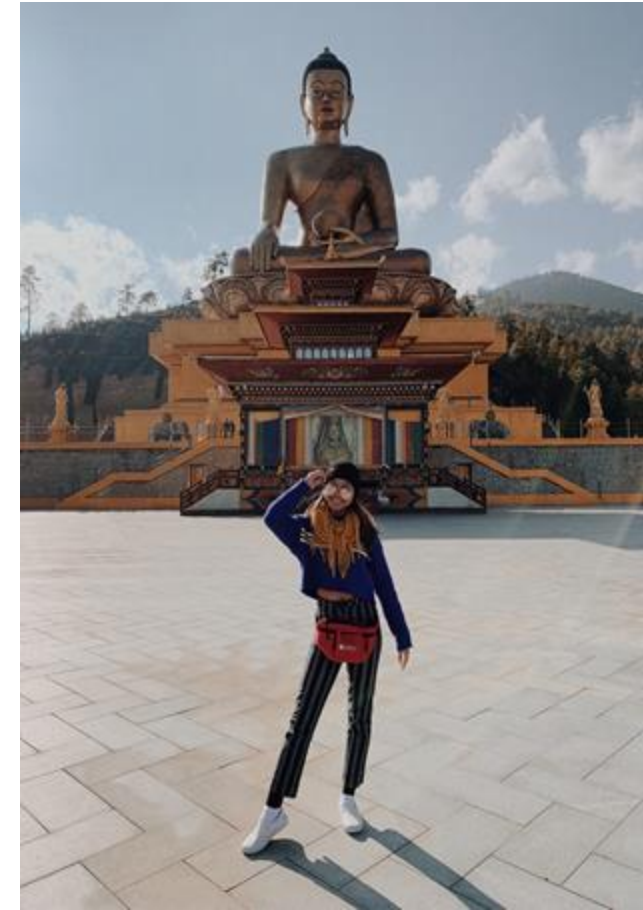

Semester/Academic Year Study Abroad

- ~90 program options in over 40 countries
- Take classes at a study abroad center, local university, or combination of both
- Satisfy major, minor, GE, themed inquiry, internships, or electives (including Global Study GE)
- Earn Chapman credit and grades, not transfer credit
- 3.0 cumulative GPA to be eligible
- Apply 1 year in advance (spring 2022 for spring 2023 abroad)
- Remain enrolled at Chapman University and pay regular Chapman tuition, room, (sometimes) board, and \$500 study abroad fee
- Apply Federal/State aid to all programs, Chapman aid to 90%
- Many scholarships available based on need and merit



Faculty-Led Travel Courses

- Occur during Interterm and summer
- International and domestic locations
- Travel with Chapman faculty and students
- 1-4 weeks, 3-4 Chapman credits
- May apply towards the Global Study GE
- No GPA requirement; all class levels may apply
- Apply one semester prior (by March 29th for Summer 2022)
- Tuition vs. Program Fee
 - Tuition may be waived
 - Program fee = out of pocket
 - Scholarships available



Great option for students who cannot go abroad for a semester due to academic or other commitments



Summer International Internships

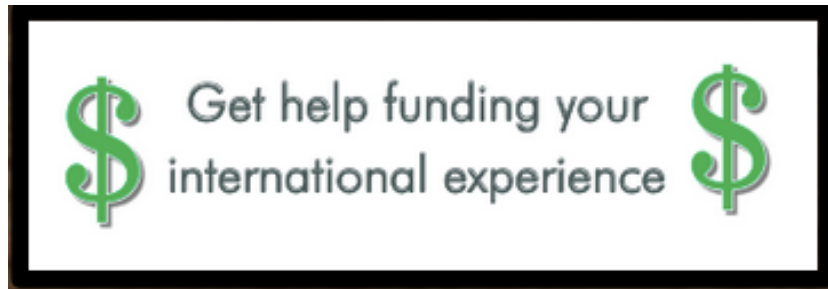
- Gain an in-depth experience into the country's social and work culture
- Customized placement by major and career interest
- 10 available locations
- 8 weeks long; 3 Chapman credits
- 3.0 cumulative GPA; Junior or Senior at time of internship
- Applications open in September and are due mid-November
- Program fee varies by location; use One-Time Tuition Waiver for up to 4 credits of tuition. Student Business Services determines eligibility.
 - Scholarships available

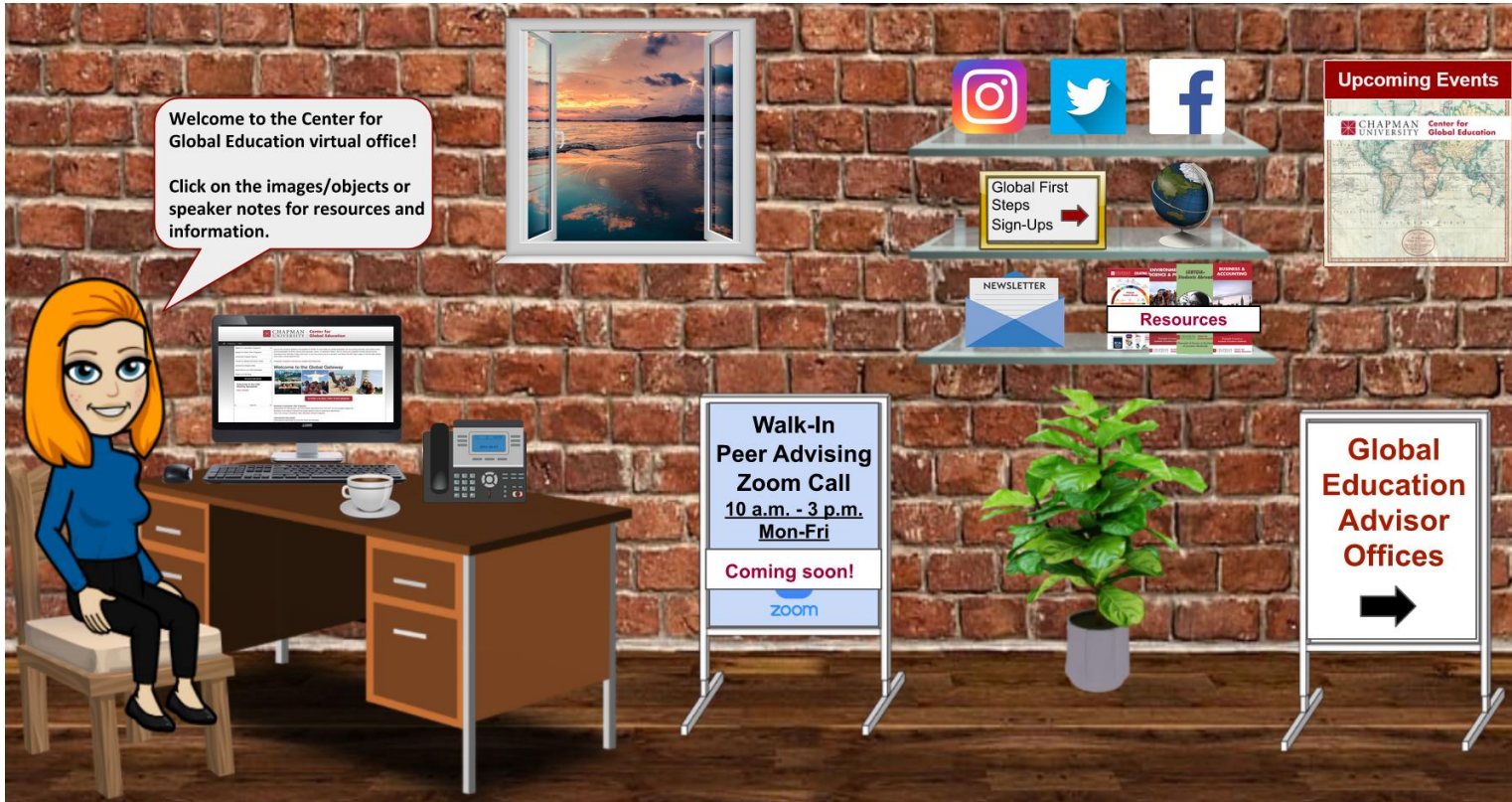
