Your scholarship does not preclude you from receiving other scholarships from Chapman as you may already know.

By accepting a talent award in dance, you are entering into an agreement to represent Chapman University as a dancer and scholar. Your level of commitment and performance is reviewed each year for renewal of the scholarship. Below are the details of the scholarship. Dance Scholarship students are required to:

- Pursue in a timely manner the BFA in Dance Performance or BA in Dance.
- Audition and be available for casting for all department concerts.
- Perform in at least two dance concerts per year.
- Enroll in a minimum of two dance technique classes per semester.
- Participate in all dance activities such as master classes, residencies, and other events.
- Maintain full time enrollment (12 units or more per semester).
- Maintain a Chapman University 2.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.0.
- Volunteer for activities each semester (auditions, Preview Days, etc.).
- Interview, if requested, with the Dance Chair during the spring semester of each year to review these terms.
