Chapman University undergraduate students can complete their bachelor's and Master's in Accounting degrees in as few as 4.5 years.

Students may take up to 12 credits of graduate coursework during their senior year, 6 of which may count toward the 120 credits required for the bachelor's. Up to 12 credits of graduate coursework taken senior year can be applied toward the 30 credits required for the MSA, allowing for accelerated completion of both degrees.

This intensive degree provides a path for graduates to prepare for the California CPA exam and meet the academic requirements for California CPA licensure, providing a competitive advantage to students as they enhance their technical and analytical skills. Students preparing to become licensed CPAs have potential placement for careers in industries such as public accounting firms, banks, insurance companies, and government.


