GENERAL ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Completed PTCAS application
- An earned B.A. or B.S. degree from a regionally accredited college or university
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 40 hours of physical therapy observation/ experience hours (supervised by a PT)
- Priority is given to complete applications

REQUIRED PREREQUISITES

- General biology with lab
- Human anatomy with lab
- Human physiology with lab
- General chemistry with lab
- General physics with lab
- Statistics
- Psychology or sociology
- * Ecology or botany courses are not accepted to fulfill biology.
- * Introductory courses are not accepted for all science courses: biology, chemistry, physics, anatomy and physiology.

Two cohorts are admitted each year to the program in the summer and fall.
