### **ONSITE TRAINING CLINIC**

All students complete one full year of supervised clinical practicum in our state-of-the-art community mental health training clinic, the **Frances Smith Center for Individual and Family Therapy**.

- Students receive both in-person and telehealth training
- Students earn hours toward licensure and gain experience working with children, teens, adults, couples and families
- The center has eight therapy rooms, six of which are equipped with two-way mirrors and digital cameras used to record sessions
- Live observation and supervision further enhance the experience
- Students receive Electronic Health Record (EHR) training



**COMMUNITY COLLABORATIONS** allow students to gain interdisciplinary clinical experience working in medical and public mental health settings.

**DISTINGUISHED FACULTY** represent a balanced diversity of nationally recognized MFTs and scholars, as well as experienced clinical instructors and supervisors.

**ADVANCED CLINICAL TRAININGS** are offered regularly and address specialized topics, giving students an opportunity to deepen their clinical knowledge in the MFT field.

**GRADUATES OF THE PROGRAM** can assess, diagnose and provide mental health services to individuals, couples and families in a variety of diverse clinical settings.
