YEAR 1: DIDACTIC EDUCATION

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Undergraduate degrees and prerequisite coursework (C or better) must be completed at a regionally accredited college or university in the United States
- Minimum overall and science GPA of 3.2
- GRE within the last five years
- U.S. Citizenship, Lawful Permanent Resident (Green Card Holder), or DACA Applicant
- Minimum 1,000 hours of direct patient contact experience
- Three letters of recommendation
- Personal statement
- PA shadowing recommended
