ABOUT THE DOCTOR OF PHARMACY (PHARM.D.) PROGRAM

The Pharm.D. is earned through a three-year, accelerated program consisting of eight, 15-week trimesters delivered year round.

- Learning-centered instruction with many class periods devoted to discussion and active learning exercises
- Apple technology and electronic access to textbooks included in tuition
- Curriculum includes small groups and team-based learning

WHAT YOU CAN FXPFCT

- You will begin your lifelong pursuit of answers to best practices for human health, patient safety, drug efficiency, and your role in the creation of those solutions.
- You will receive a Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) degree that prepares you for licensure to practice pharmacy in a wide range of settings. You may also choose to continue your studies in advanced practice specialization or research.
- You will learn through a unique "flipped classroom" approach where you acquire basic knowledge outside class and apply that knowledge to real cases and problems in class with expert faculty help.
- You will participate in patient care simulations with students in other health care programs to develop leadership and teamwork skills.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for admission, the applicant must meet the following requirements:

- Letter grade of C or higher for all prerequisite courses
- Preferred applicants have an overall and prerequisite GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Two letters of recommendation
- A criminal background check, drug screening and up-to-date immunization record will be required for all applicants offered admission
