\* Test scores are waived for Transfer applicants with 24+ completed semester units. The final high school transcript is waived for Transfer applicants with 60+ completed semester units.

### International Students

- International Supplement Form (all international applicants). This form will be available on the student's Application Status Page once the application has been submitted.
- Financial verification (for students expecting to hold an F-1 student visa). This will be submitted as part of the International Supplement Form.

## ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

Proof of English proficiency is required for non-native English speakers:

- Minimum TOEFL score of 80 iBT (with balanced sub scores)
- Minimum IELTS score of 6.5 (with balanced sub scores)

**I NOTE:** *Transfer applicants: International students studying in the United States must have completed a transferrable English class in a traditional classroom setting. Online English courses do not satisfy this requirement. International students studying overseas must submit a test of English proficiency.*

## CREATIVE SUPPLEMENT

Applicants to all academic majors within the Department of Art (excluding Art History), College of Performing Arts and Dodge College of Film & Media Arts must submit a Creative Supplement.

Submission requirements vary by major. Please click on your academic major below to review your specific requirements.
