

CHAPMAN UNIVERSITY: COST OF ATTENDANCE BREAKDOWN

FOR UNDERGRADUATE INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS - FALL 2018 & SPRING 2019

The following is a breakdown of the estimated cost of attendance for undergraduate international students at Chapman University for the **2018-2019** academic year. All international students studying in the U.S. are required to have health insurance (whether it is their own, or what is offered by Chapman University). **All rates are subject to change.**

ANNUAL ESTIMATED COST OF A CHAPMAN EDUCATION IN US DOLLARS

For planning purposes, it is safe to estimate a 4% increase in the yearly cost of attendance.

If you plan to bring family to the United States, you will be required to verify additional funds for their expenses. The estimated expenses for dependents is as follows:

UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Chapman is need-aware for international students intending to hold an F-1 Student Visa. All students interested in being considered for aid must submit an International Supplement Form, including the required financial verification.

International students are eligible for merit-based scholarship during the admission process. First Year scholarships range in amount up to \$32,000 per year. Transfer scholarships range in amount up to \$12,000 per year. Merit-based scholarships are awarded based upon the applicant's performance on standardized tests and in the classroom, strength of curriculum and at the discretion of the Admission Committee.

Chapman offers *limited* need-based aid for international applicants.

! **NOTE:** Scholarship amounts will not change due to unforeseen circumstances in your financial situation, including but not limited to: family difficulties, political changes in your home country, currency devaluations or fluctuations, etc. Be prepared to cover all costs associated with attending Chapman University for the duration of your degree program.
