

# Semester/Academic Year Study Abroad

- Fall, Spring, or Academic Year
- Apply 1 year in advance (apply now for Spring 2025)
- 80+ program options in 40+ countries
- Earn Chapman credit and grades
- Satisfy major, minor, GE, themed inquiry, or electives
- Automatically satisfy Global Studies Inquiry (6 credit GE)
- Internships & research available



# Faculty-Led Travel Courses

- Interterm (January) or Summer
- Apply 1 semester before
- International and domestic programs
- Chapman faculty and students
- 1-4 weeks; 3-4 Chapman credits
- International programs satisfy portion of Global Studies Inquiry GE
- Great option for students who cannot go abroad for a full semester




# International Internships

- Summer
- Apply in the Fall semester
- Australia, Ireland, Spain, New Zealand, Czech Republic, Japan, Vietnam, South Korea, & Thailand
- Customized placement by major and career interest
- 8 weeks long; 3 Chapman credits
- Satisfy portion of Global Studies Inquiry GE



# Summer Sessions Abroad

- Apply Fall semester before
- Summer Sessions Abroad will have other international students on the program and classes are taught by other local and international faculty.
- 1-4 courses depending on term length and credit amounts.
- Students can satisfy major, minor, GE (including the Global Studies GE), or other degree requirements on these programs. Prices and length vary by program.



## **COST**

- ✓ Program fees vary by type of program
- ✓ Financial aid may be applicable depending on program type
- ✓ Tuition waivers available for international summer programs
- ✓ Study abroad scholarships available

## **STUDENTS' NEXT STEPS**

- ✓ Attend a **Global First Steps** session to learn about all program types and application processes. Offered weekly.
- ✓ Meet with a **Global Education Advisor** by major to guide them before, during, and after their global experience.
- ✓ Select a program(s) and complete an application.
