Located in Beckman 403, the OCPP (Office of Career Planning and Placement), was established in the ASBE in 2009 to: (1) provide career management programs and services to undergraduate business, accounting, and economics students, (2) develop business relationships with local employers to identify full-time and internship positions for students, and (3) conduct a comprehensive on-campus recruitment program for local employers seeking accounting students.

Service highlights include:

- Resume and cover letter critique
- Career Leader assessment test
- Practice interviewing
- Career management workshops
- On-line job postings and internships
- On-campus recruitment program for accounting students
