What is Drilling Down?

Definition:

This is the action you take to access more detailed / granular information within a specific report.

How to Drill Down?

1) Setup your slicers

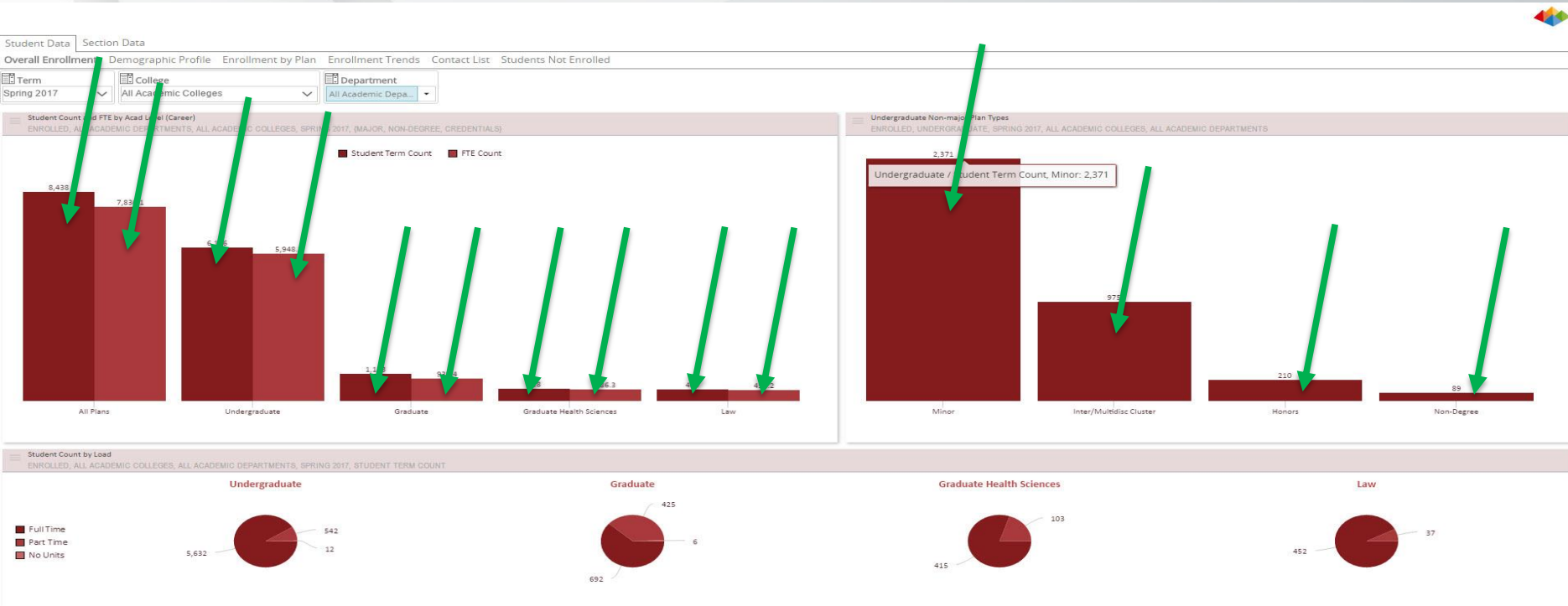

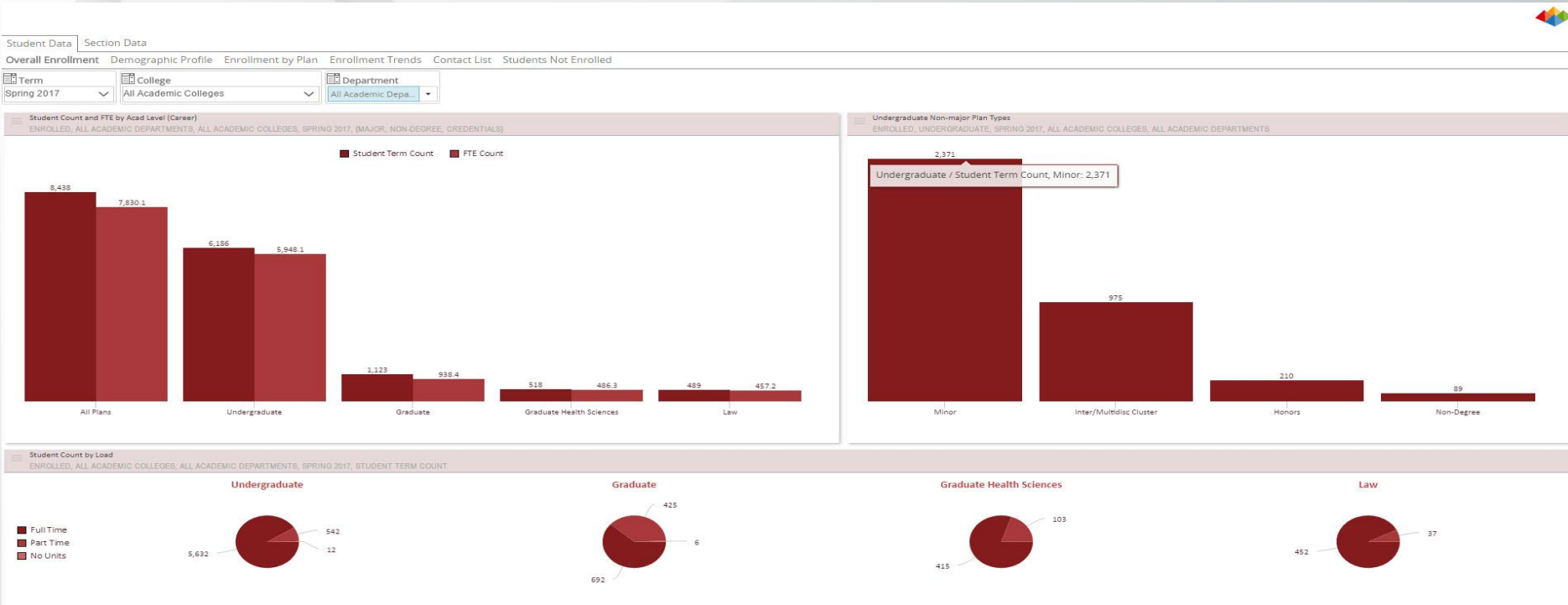
How to Drill Down?
