
What are Slicers?

Definition:

Slicers are search filters that you would set in order to generate specific data sets or “queries”.

How to set Slicers?

- 1) Click on one of the 3 fields to access available query search menu options.

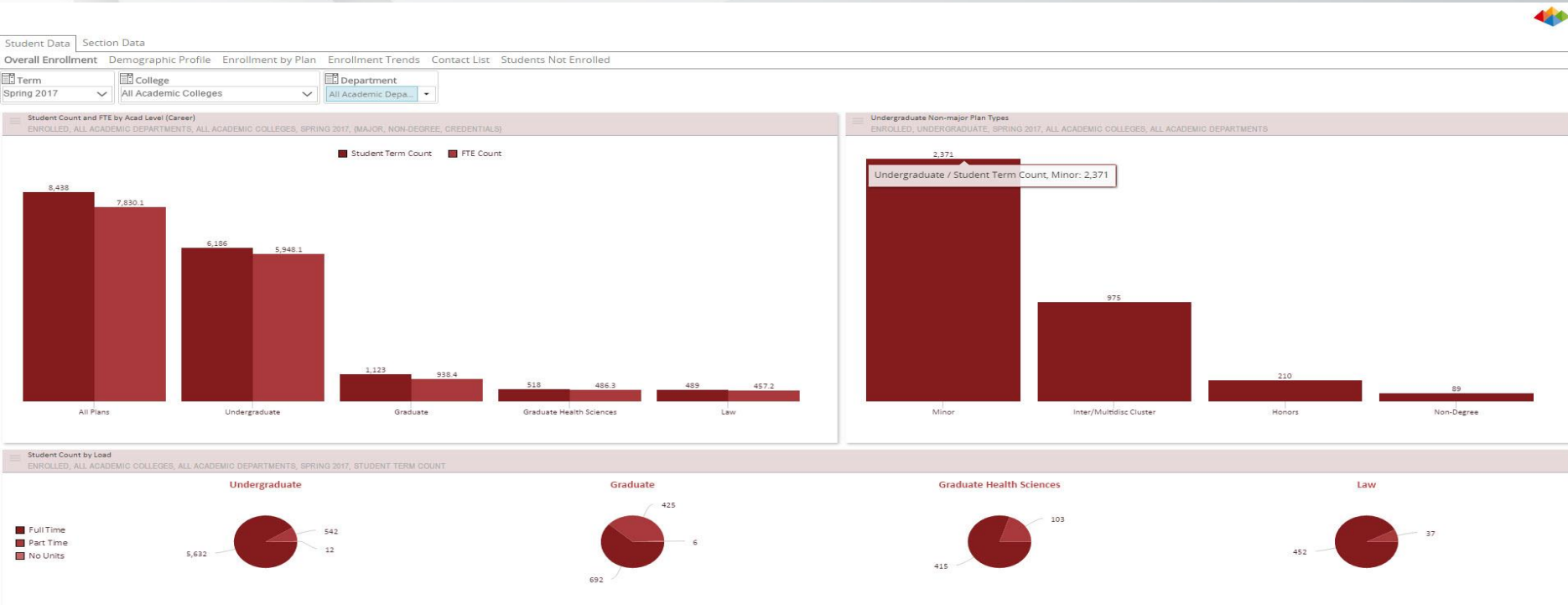
