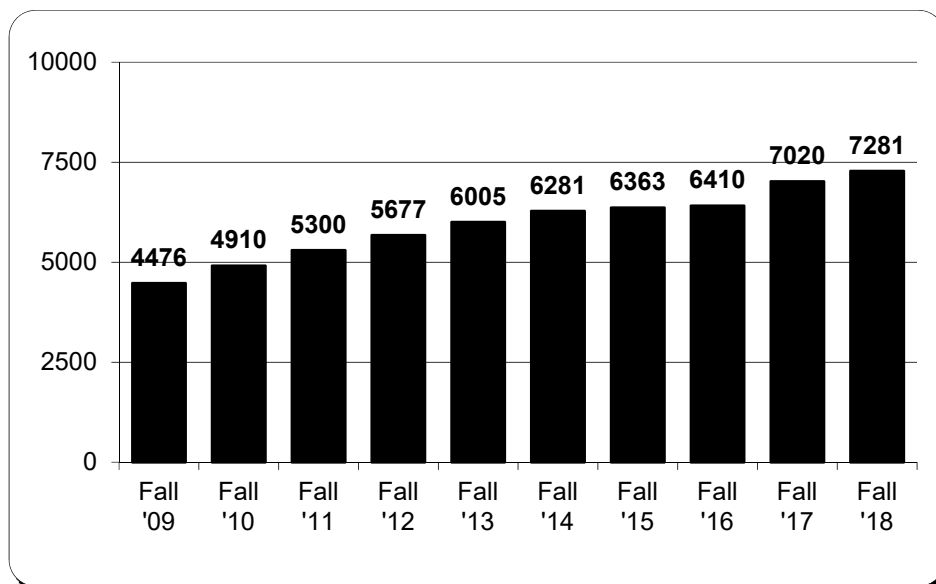


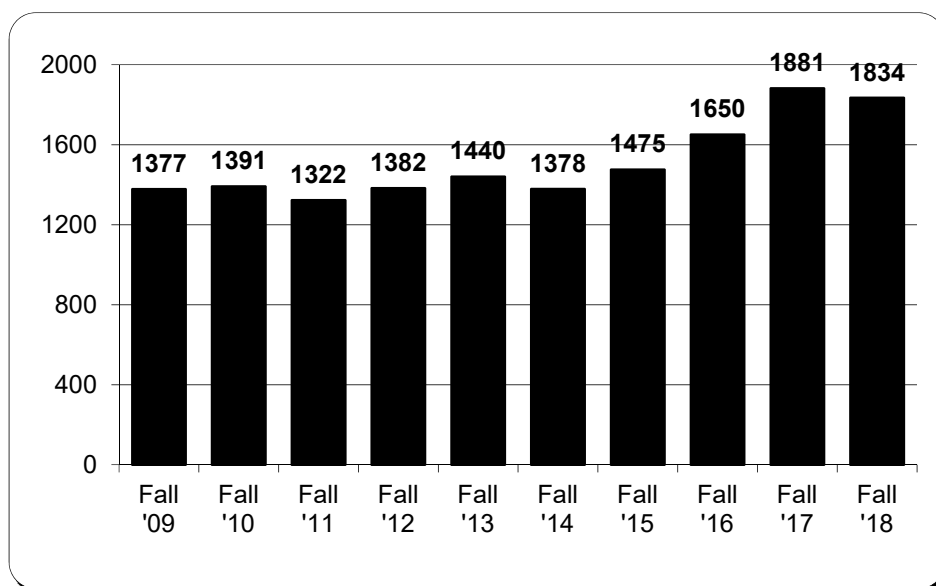

## *Graduate Headcount Enrollment*

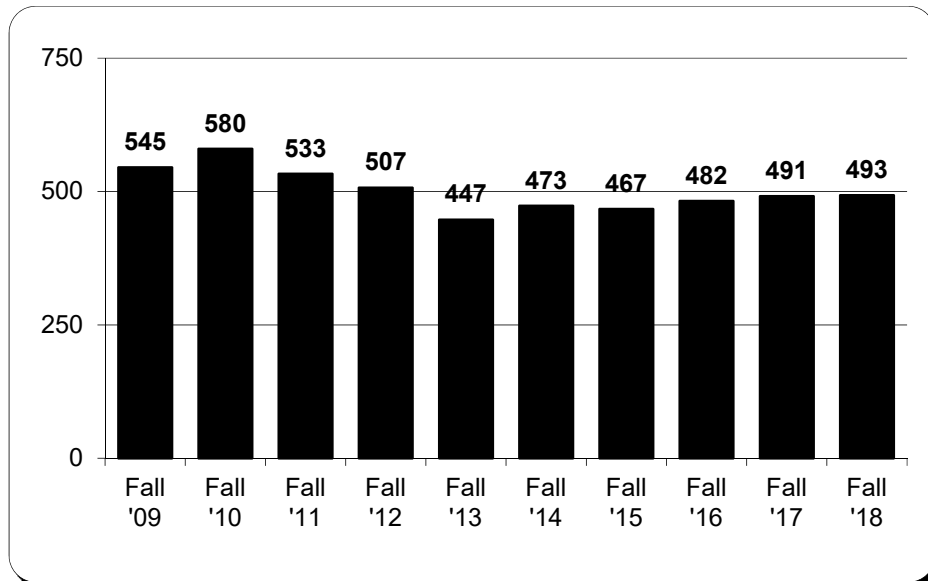

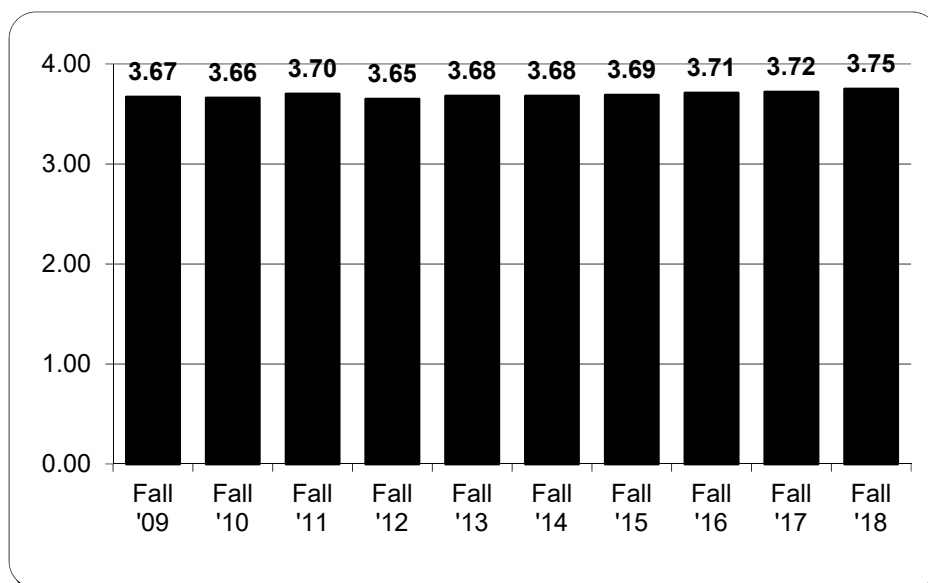
## *Juris Doctor Headcount Enrollment*

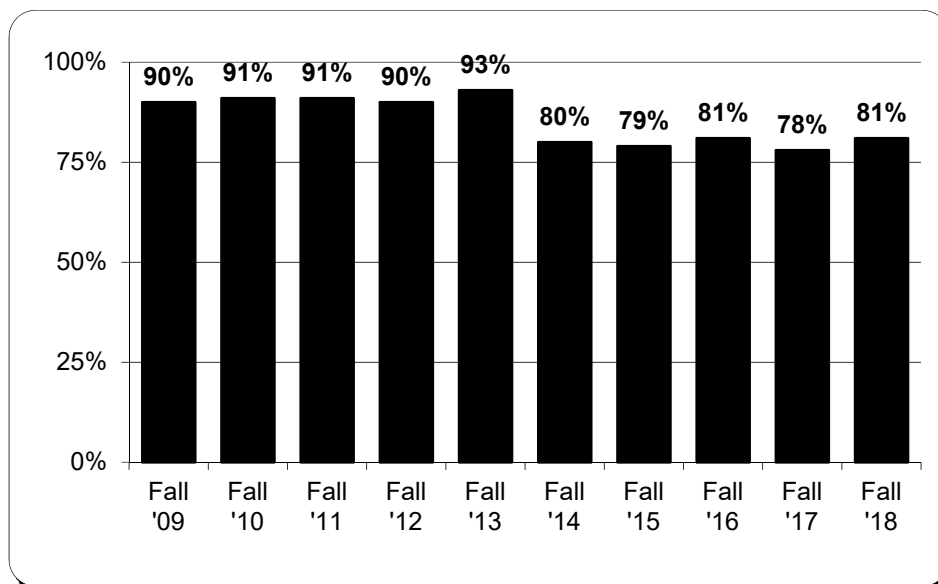

## *Average High School GPA of New Freshmen*



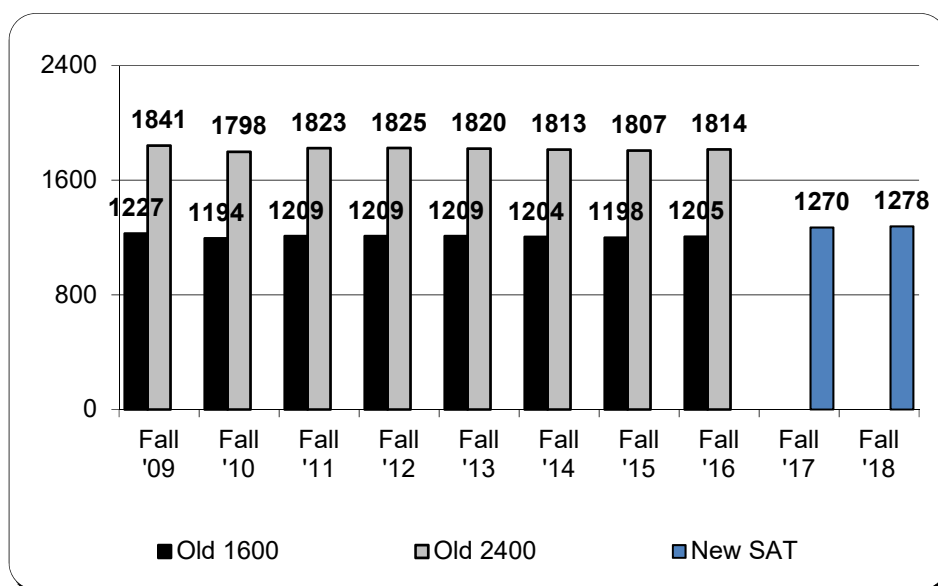

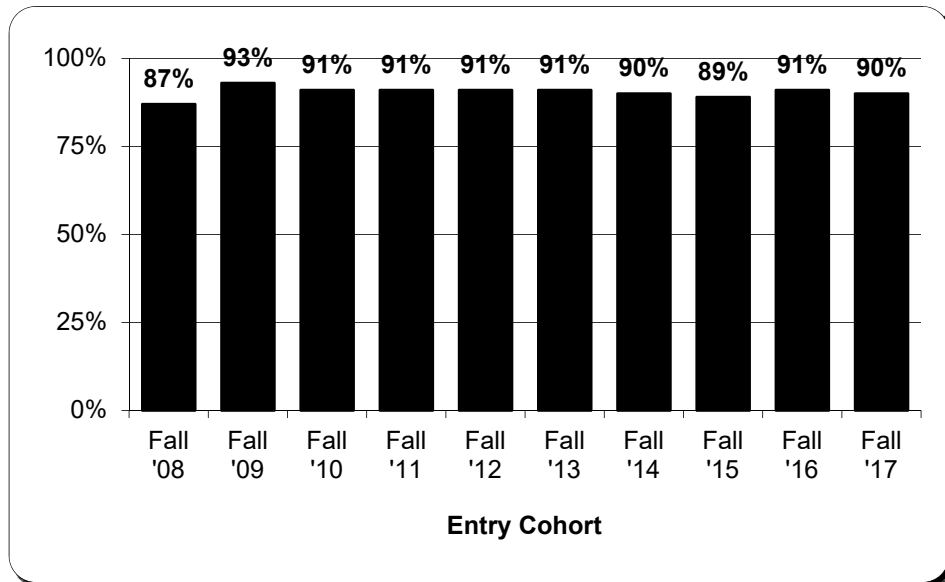
## Average SAT Score of New Freshmen

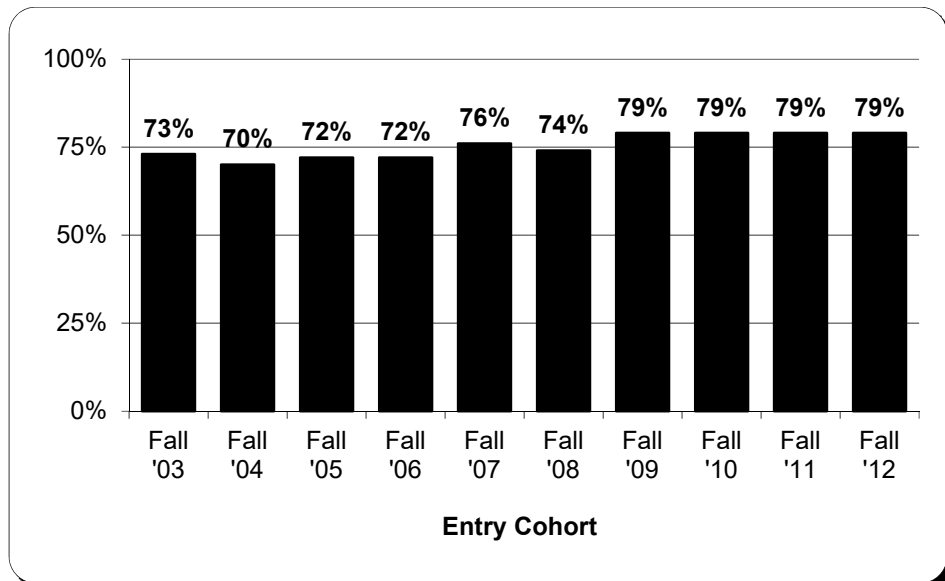

## *Fall-to-Fall Retention Rate of First-time Freshmen*



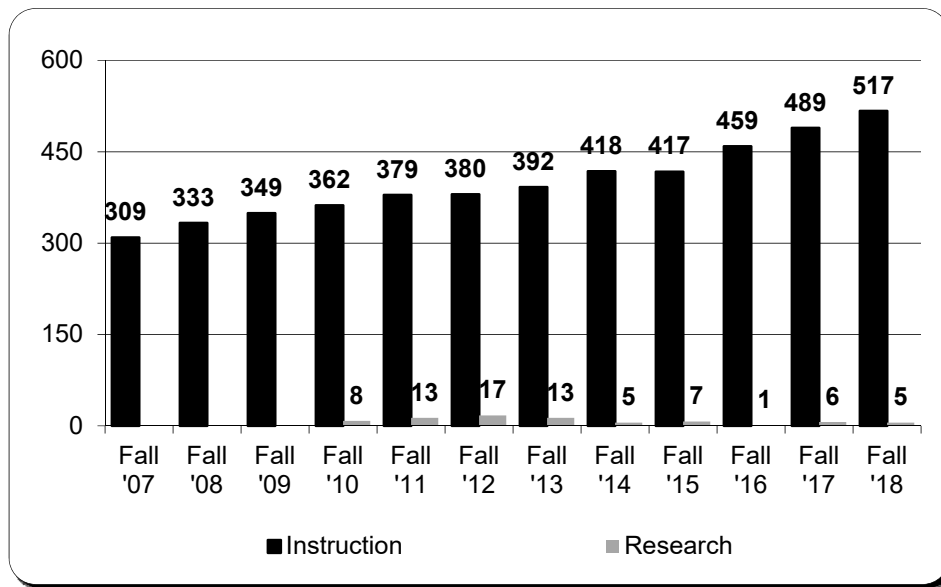

## *Six-Year Graduation Rate of First-time Freshmen*



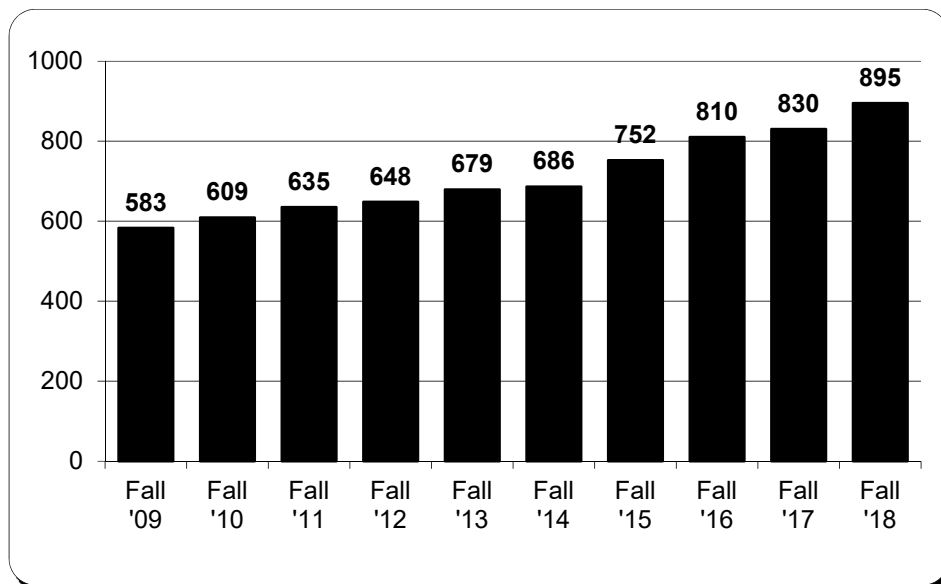
