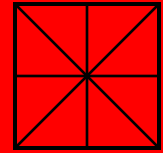

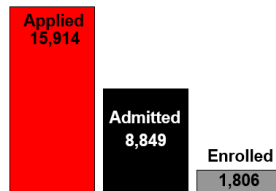

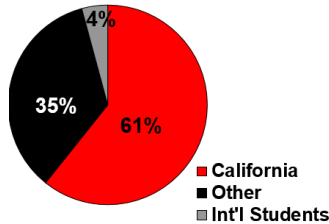

### Fall 2023 First Year Class Characteristics

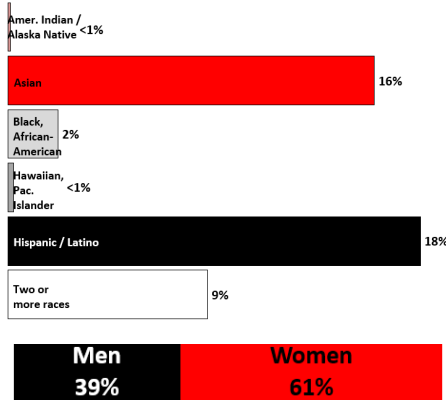

### Geographic Origin



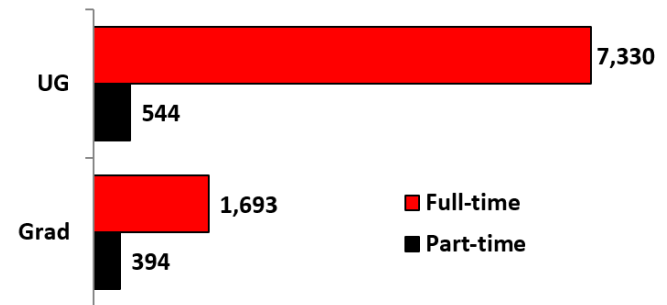
### Diversity of Fall '23 Full-time Undergrads

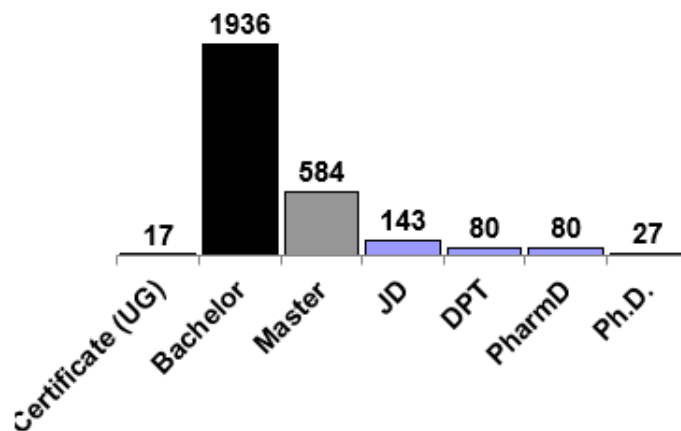

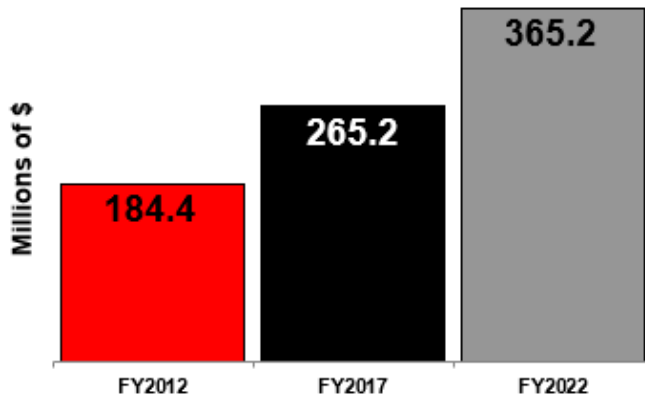

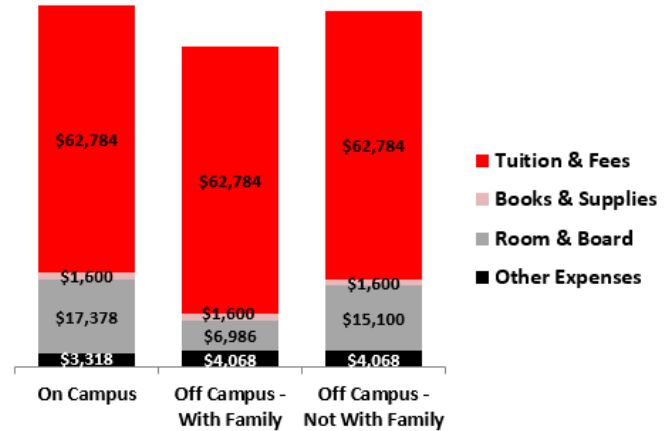

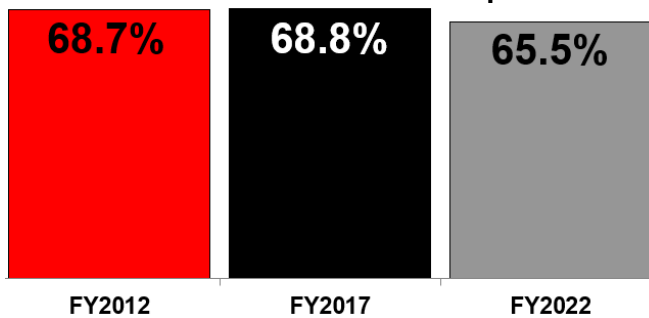
## Educational Expenditures



## Estimated Costs of Attendance (2023-24 Undergraduates)



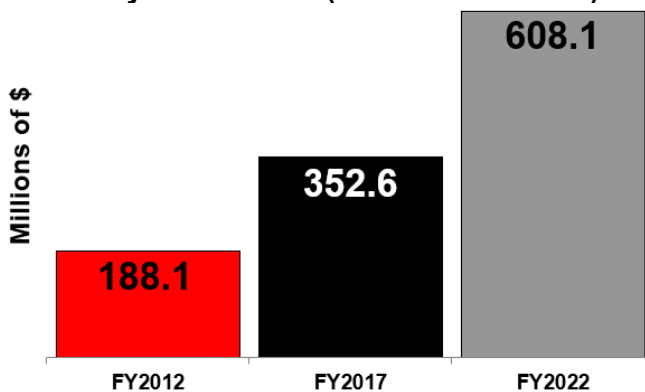
## Instruction and Academic Support Expenses as Percent of Total Educational Expenses
