Every fall, the University publishes its Annual Security and Fire Safety Report. Traditionally, this is published no later than October 1. However, this year, the Department of Education has extended this deadline to December 31, 2020 in order to give institutions more time, given the challenges surrounding COVID-19. We wanted to let our community know that we will be publishing the annual report later in the year in compliance with the guidance.

The report contains information on campus security and personal safety, crime prevention, university police-law enforcement authority, crime reporting policies, student conduct, and other important matters about security on both the Main Campus and The Rinker Health Science Campus. It also contains statistics for the three previous calendar years on reported crimes that occurred on campus, in off-campus property owned or controlled by Chapman University, and on public property within or immediately adjacent to and accessible from the campus.

Additionally, the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act requires institutions of higher education to send all students and employees an annual notification of its program to prevent the unlawful possession, use, or distribution of illegal drugs and alcohol. This notification is available at [Federal Drug-Free Schools and Communities Regulations](#) and contains information about the employee and student policies, a description of health risks associated with alcohol and other drug use, and information about local treatment programs.
