The Attallah College teacher education, counseling, and psychology programs are designed around providing students with personalized education experience. We offer small class sizes, close contact with an array of full time faculty and part time faculty who are active teachers, counselors, and psychologist. Further, all of our students are supported by individual program coordinators, faculty, university supervisors, mentors, and staff all along their credential path from guidance and support for prospective students, applicants, candidates, and alumni within the Attallah College. Additionally, all of our programs are supported by our [TE Credentials Support Staff](#) and [Counseling and Psychology Support Staff](#), each of whom are knowledgeable of each of our teacher education programs as well as our counseling and psychology programs. Our Administrative Support staff is always available to help prospective students, applicants, candidates, and alumni with questions, forms, and setting up appointments with Coordinators, faculty or anyone else on campus as needed.

As part of a campus-wide expansion of career support at Chapman, Attallah students and alumni have access to university-wide career services through the [Office of Career and Professional Development](#) and program-specific guidance embedded within the College. The College staffs a full-time career advisor who supports both students and alumni. Attallah's program-specific career services include campus visits from local school districts as well as assistance with career portfolios (resume, CV, cover letter, online profile, etc.), job searches and applications, interview preparation and practice, and networking events.
