

6.1. Table identifying the number of hours required for certification in speech language pathology. Candidates must complete a minimum of 400 clock hours of supervised clinical experience in the practice of speech language pathology. Twenty five hours must be spent in clinical observation and 375 hours must be spent in direct client/student/patient contact.
