Basic Use

- Use remote to Power on screen
- Set television on HDMI 1 to reflect computer activity
- Power On keyboard and mouse for use
- On Computer, use Chapman login credentials
- Upon completion:
 - Log Off from computer
 - Power Off television, keyboard and mouse

USB-Drive

- Look behind the television
- On the left side, locate computer
- Place USB into USB port

Using your laptop

- Look behind the television
- On the upper right side, locate HDMI cable
- Connect HDMI cable to your computer
- **If you have a Mac, please bring your adaptor for HDMI**
- Use remote to set television on HDMI 3
- Take note of cable's length (not too long)
- Upon completion: Power Off television

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Using Apple TV

- Use remote to set television on Apple TV (HDMI 2)
- On your iPhone, iPad or Mac (iDevice):
 - Use "Chapman Open" Wi-Fi 
 - Turn On "Airplay" 
 - Select "Screen mirroring" 
 - Choose this Apple TV: C07VR5WNJ1WF
- A code will appear on the television
- Enter code in your iDevice

- Upon completion:
 - On your device select "Stop mirroring"
 - Power Off television

Apple TV without using same Wi-Fi

- Turn On Wi-Fi & Bluetooth for both iDevices
- For Macs, choose your Apple TV from the AirPlay status menu in the upper right screen menu bar
- For iDevices use Control Center to connect to AirPlay
- If your Apple TV asks for a code for airplay, enter that code
