SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

For Chapman University Health Welfare Plan

This is a summary of the annual report of the Chapman University Health Welfare Plan, EIN 95-1643992, Plan No. 501, for period January 01, 2011 through December 31, 2011. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Chapman University has committed itself to pay certain self-funded Dental claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Blue Cross of California, Kaiser Foundation Health Plan, Inc., Delta Dental of California, Vision Service Plan, Standard Insurance Company, Ceridian Corporation and Hyatt Legal Plans, Inc. to pay Medical, Dental, Vision, Life Insurance, Short-term Disability, Long-term Disability, Accidental Death and Dismemberment and Legal claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2011 were \$14,497,448.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2011, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$1,287,381 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these contracts during the plan year was \$703,969.
