

Tuition Discount Benefit for Impacted Programs

In accordance with the Chapman University Tuition Discount Benefit, certain graduate programs which are “impacted or limited in size”, are not eligible for the granting of tuition discount.

Senior Staff has determined that the following programs will not be eligible for full tuition discount:

- Travel Courses
- Juris Doctor
- LL.M in Taxation
- Doctor of Physical Therapy
- MFA in Film Production
- Master of Art in Educational Psychology
- Executive Master of Business Administration
- All Ph.D programs
- All Ed.D programs
- All Pharm.D and Pharmacy programs

Consistent with the terms for the benefit plan, employees and dependents who apply for and are accepted into the programs after the programs are deemed to be discount-ineligible will receive a 30% tuition discount for enrollment in these programs. Once an employee or dependent is admitted with full tuition discount to an academic program which later becomes limited, he/she may continue in the program through completion with full tuition discount, as long as all other eligibility criteria and conditions described in the benefit plan, Tuition Discount Benefits, are met.

Special Courses that Qualify for Tuition Remission:

- Undergrad Study Abroad - one-time only
- Audit courses
