Connecting your Smart TV / Gaming System to Wi-Fi

While laptops, tablets, and cell phones can connect to the Eduroam Wi-Fi network, devices like Smart TVs are unable to connect to Eduroam. You must connect these devices (Smart TV, Gaming Console, Alexa, etc.) to the <u>Chapman Open</u> Wi-Fi network. To do so requires that you register these devices. Device registration lets you use Chapman Open Wi-Fi for up to a year without having to click accept.

To register your device, you will need to know the MAC address of your device. A MAC address is a unique identifier that is assigned to a device that can connect to a network, such as a smart TV, and will look be a combination of numbers and letters in this format: 00:1A:2B:3C:4D:5E.

Steps to Locate a MAC Address of your Smart TV

The steps to locate a MAC address of a smart TV may vary depending on the brand and model of your TV, but here are some general guidelines:

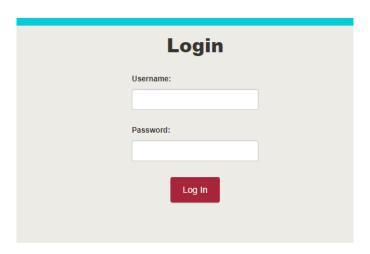
- Turn on your smart TV and connect it to your network.
- Press the Menu or Home button on your remote control.
- Navigate to the Settings or Network menu.
- Select Network Status, Network Information, or a similar option.
- Look for an option that says MAC Address, Physical Address, or Hardware Address.
- Write down the MAC address of your smart TV.

Once you know the MAC address of the TV or device, you can now register it.

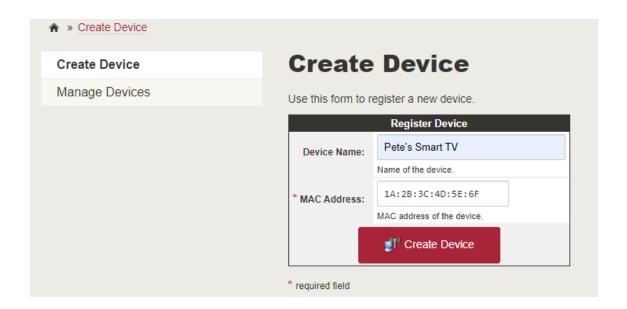
Registering your TV or Smart Device for Chapman Open

Connect your device to the Chapman Open Wi-Fi network.

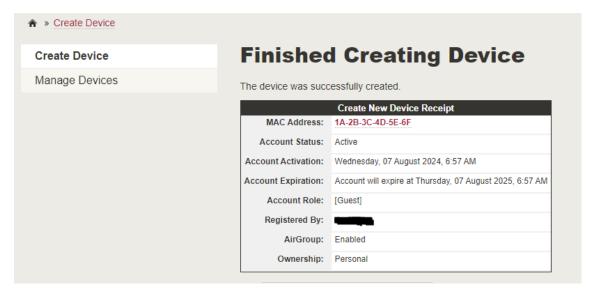
- From a computer or laptop already connected to Chapman's network (either eduroam or Chapman Open), go to the Device Registration page at https://cppm.chapman.edu/guest/auth_login.php and log in with your Chapman username and password.



Enter a name for your device and the device's Mac Address you located beforehand, and Click Create Device.



After clicking on Create Device, you will see a page letting you know the device was successfully created:



Next, *disconnect the device you registered from wifi and wait for 6 minutes*. Then reconnect to **Chapman Open**. Your device is should now be properly registered and connected to the Chapman Open network.
