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RESEARCH OVERVIEW

My programmatic line of research investigates how affect regulation strategies can be capitalized upon to reduce racial health disparities among children. Taking a developmental approach, my work demonstrates that the success of affect regulation strategies is context dependent, thus needing to match the situational nuances at hand. I investigate these nuances in both acute and chronic contexts by working with diverse children recovering from surgery, children with cancer, and adolescents with asthma as well as the adults (parents, healthcare providers) who care for these children. I test health outcomes such as pain, surgical recovery, and asthma disease severity, as well as physiological functioning (e.g., autonomic nervous system activity, antibody response) and health behaviors (e.g., sleep, medication usage). I further extend this literature by examining the dynamics of affect over time, developing methods for assessing these affective patterns and uncovering how affect dynamics are tied to health. Building on these findings, I test causal pathways by designing and implementing affect regulation interventions. I apply a positive psychology approach by not just downregulating negative affect but implementing strategies to upregulate positive affect. Working both in the lab and clinical environments, I use a multi-method, theoretically driven approach to solve racial health inequity problems. I apply rigorous study designs and advanced data analytic techniques, including multilevel modeling, spline growth curve modeling, structural equation modeling, survival analysis, and nonlinear methods. A unique aspect of my work is the development of scales and methods to accurately measure health-relevant outcomes and the dynamic aspects of affect.
