Notes:

- 1) All new freshmen are required to complete a First-year Foundations Course [FFC 100] in their first year of enrollment. It is recommended you enroll in this class in your first semester as a larger number of course sections and topics are available in the fall semester.
- 2) When you see “GE” listed above, that means you can choose a General Education (GE) class from ANY GE category – it’s your choice!
In general, the following GE areas are recommended to begin/complete during the first year:
 - GE Language Study (strongly recommended)
 - GE Quantitative Inquiry
- 3) In their first semester, students typically take 12-15 credits (most classes are 3 credits; those with labs are 4). 12 credits are required to be in full-time status.
- 4) As an incoming first-year student, you must take a math assessment. If you place into Math 100 (Learning and Studying Mathematics for Understanding), then you must enroll in this course in your first year (fall or spring semester).
