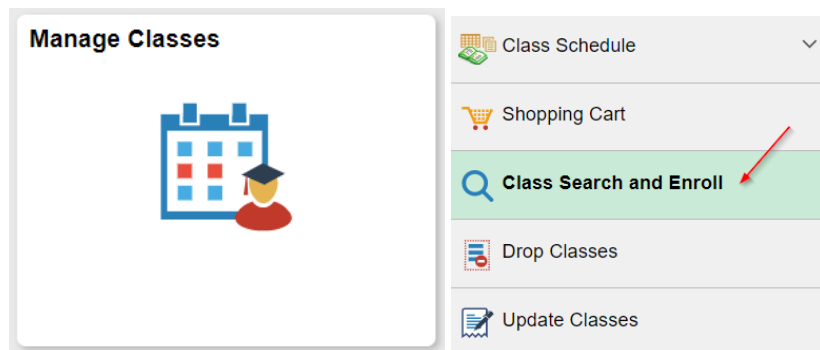

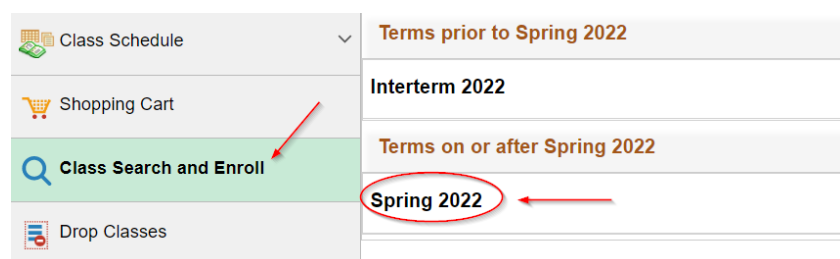
- **GENERAL EDUCATION** - At the simplest level, Chapman University's General Education (GE) Program is a common set of requirements that all undergraduates must fulfill, regardless of major. But General Education is much more than just a set of requirements; it is a set of choices that allow students to customize their academic experience. Baccalaureate degree-seeking students must take a minimum of 45- 46 credits in 4 different General Education areas in order to graduate.

General Education:

- ✓ is the core of your undergraduate education
- ✓ provides some commonality across majors
- ✓ provides background in key academic areas
- ✓ is the framework for course work in your major
- ✓ prepares you to be a global citizen

Things to Remember:

- You can share up to 9 credits of your major and up to 6 credits of your minor with the GE Shared Inquiry or Global Citizen Cluster areas
 - You may not share courses/credits in the Inter-Multidisciplinary Cluster with your major program courses or other GE areas
 - General Education courses do not have to be saved for a semester study abroad
 - You can search for courses that apply to specific GE areas by searching specific GE categories using the drop-down boxes in the "Search for Classes" link shown below:
- The first step is click on Class Search and Enroll, and choose the term you'd like to search. In this example, we will search for classes in Spring 2022:



This will take you to the general class search window:

Click on “Additional ways to search”:

- A pop up window will appear in the middle of the screen. Go down to where you see “Class Attribute” listed:

- Click on the drop-down box below “Class Attribute” to view and select the specific GE area you want to search for:
