Certification must be completed prior to the student's first semester admitted, enrolled and attending.

A course may be approved for multiple areas but can only be applied towards one. Up to 9 credits may be shared between major courses and GE Shared Inquiry and/or Global Citizen Clusters.

A minimum grade of C- is required for all transfer coursework.
