Using the Tutoring Center

Tutoring at Chapman University is provided as a free service to all students currently enrolled. Tutoring is available for most subjects. All students are provided with one hour per week of one on one tutoring for each course they are currently enrolled in plus many opportunities for group sessions. To request a tutor, come into the TLT Center in DeMille 130 to fill out a request form.

Become a Tutor

Tutors are hired in all subjects based on the current need. We accept both work study and non-work study! Candidates must have received an A in the courses they wish to tutor, an overall GPA of at least 3.0, and a faculty recommendation. Come by our office in DeMille 130 to fill out an application.

Supplemental Instruction

Supplemental Instruction (SI) provides additional support for courses which are traditionally considered more difficult for some students. SI leaders attend lectures to keep up to date on course material and then hold group sessions to provide additional help to enhance student course performance.
