Obtaining Verified Tax Information

For academic year 2025-2026, your 2023 taxes must be verified. The preferred method to verify income is by using the **Future Act Direct Data Exchange** (FA-DDX) on your FAFSA at **studentaid.gov**. Most students will be eligible to use the FA-DDX. If not, here are additional options:

A 2023 Tax Return Transcript may be obtained through:

- Online Request – Go to www.irs.gov/transcript. Click “Get Transcript Online” or “Get Transcript by Mail”.
- Telephone Request – 1-800-908-9946.
- Paper Request – IRS Form 4506-T. Check box #6a. Form must be sent to the IRS directly.

Verification of Non-Filing:

Provide a signed and dated statement certifying that the individual has not filed and is not required to file a 2023 income tax return, as well as the sources of 2023 income earned from work and the amount of income from each source.

Amended Tax Returns: If you or your spouse filed an amended 2023 tax return, submit a signed copy of the 1040X form in addition to the 2023 tax return transcript.

Foreign Tax Returns: Submit a signed copy of the 2023 income tax return that was filed with the relevant tax authority. Include English and US Dollar translation. If you did not file, submit Verification of Non-Filing from your foreign country.
