Majoring and Minoring in Creative Writing or English

The Department of English at Chapman University encourages students to read widely and deeply, to write boldly and thoughtfully, and to engage in interdisciplinary scholarship and creative activity. Our English students and faculty explore and create the stories that shape our worlds. Undergraduate students may pursue a BFA in Creative Writing or a BA in English: either in literature, rhetoric, and cultural studies or in journalism.
