

## Bachelor of Arts in Sociology - Recommended Sociology Major Course Map

Students pursuing the B.A. in Sociology are required to: maintain at least a 2.000 GPA in the major, earn a grade of "C-" or higher in core courses in the major, complete all core courses for a letter grade, complete 21 credits from upper division courses

- **Sociology Elective courses: ANTH courses, HON 206, HON 209, HON 215, HON 313, HUM 102, HUM 310, HUM 313, SOC courses & WMST courses.**
- The following courses may be repeated: SOC 295, SOC 329, SOC 347, SOC 395, SOC 429, SOC 480, SOC 490, SOC 492a, SOC 492B and any individual study courses.
- Students need an average of 15 credits per semester to graduate in four years. Fill in your schedule with courses that fulfill requirements for the general education program, your minor, or your cluster.
- Please review your program evaluation each semester and meet regularly with your academic and/or program advisor to review your progress.
